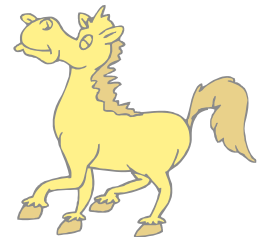
Presidents Report.

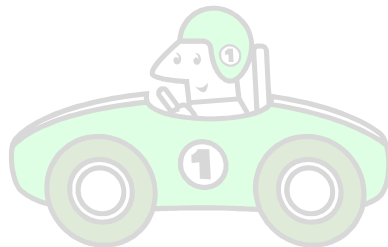
The teacher kindly allowed them to do a re-test after 3 days.
