We don't want any accidents happening.

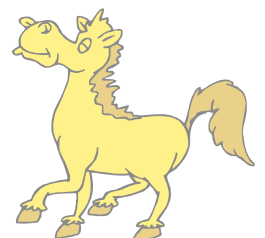

# UNIFORMS

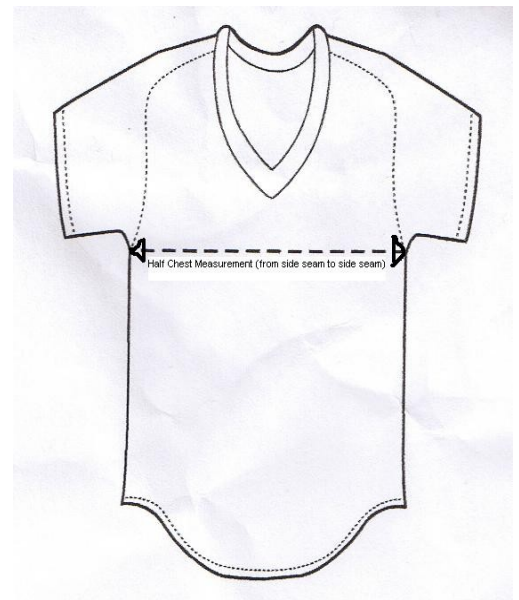


The new shirts have been decided upon and the first order will be going in soon, shirts will need to be pre ordered through the club (payment on delivery), final price is not set however they will be between \$25 and \$30.

They are made from 65% polyester and 35% cotton pique knit. Low pill yarn, Knitted collar and cuff, Side splits with twill tape and will be in either a ladies tapered fit or men's straight fit (your choice)

To find the size you require lay a shirt you find comfortable wearing on a flat surface and measure from side seam to side seam (across the bust) to get a measurement in cm's. (This is called a half chest measurement).
